bonus campaign guidelines

- Qualifying Medicare Supplement sales include Underwritten, Open Enrollment and Birth-day/Anniversary Rule issued plans. To qualify, five plans must be submitted during a month between January 1, 2023, through March 31, 2023.
- Plans must be issued and in force for a minimum of two months, with premium paid, to qualify for the bonus.
- At least five plans must be sold during a month to receive a bonus for that month. Once the
 requirements have been met, the bonus will apply to all sales made during the month. At
 the start of a new month, the bonus will reset and five more plans must be sold to requalify
 for the bonus.
- Agents must be appropriately licensed and appointed with National Health Insurance Company or American Heritage Life Insurance Company on the dates the sales are made and the bonus is paid.
- Bonus payments will be made to the same agent/agency to whom the applicable commissions related to the sales of the Allstate Health Solutions Medicare Supplement Insurance plans.
- Bonus money will be considered taxable income and reported on recipient's FORM 1099-MISC.
- Bonuses will be paid no more than 90 days following the end of the campaign.
